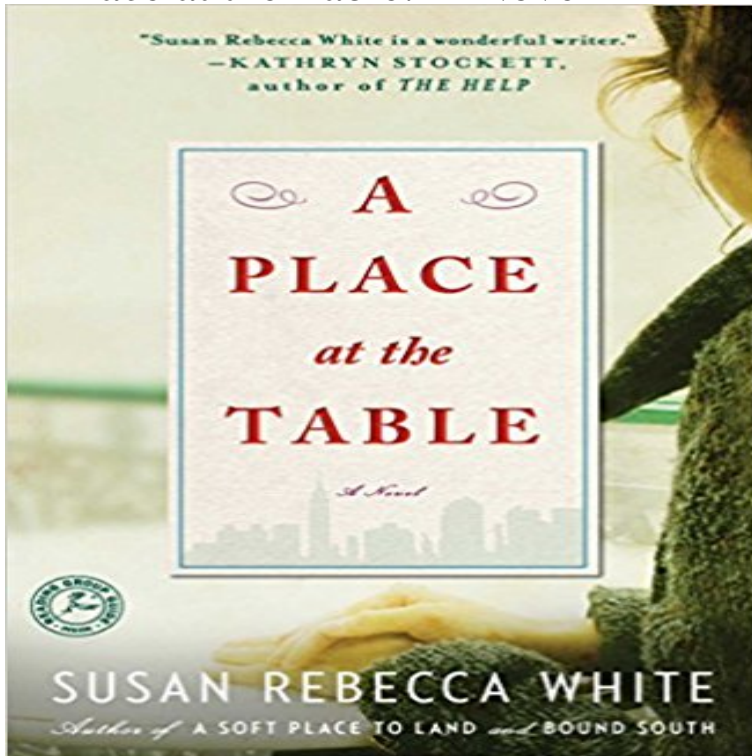


## A Place at the Table: A Novel
