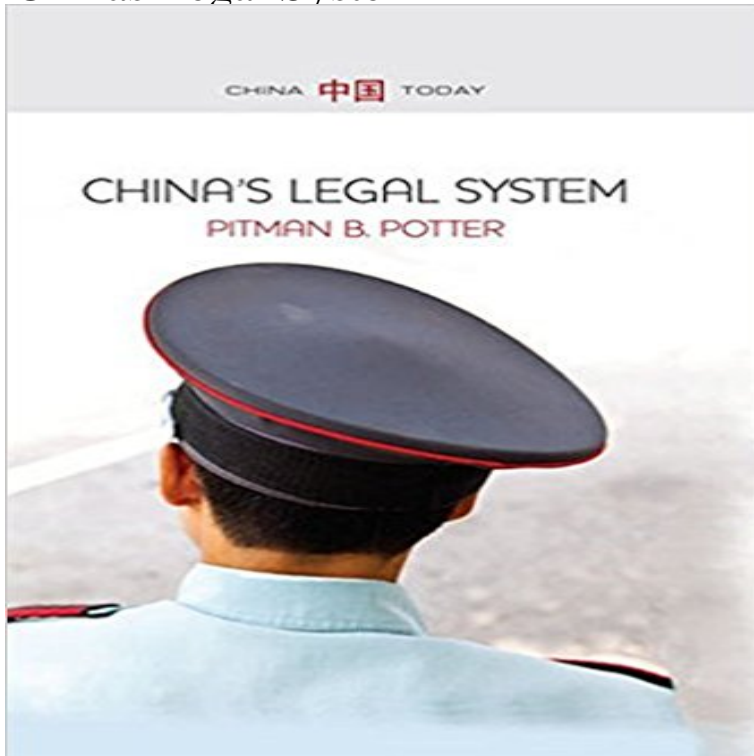


Chinas Legal System
