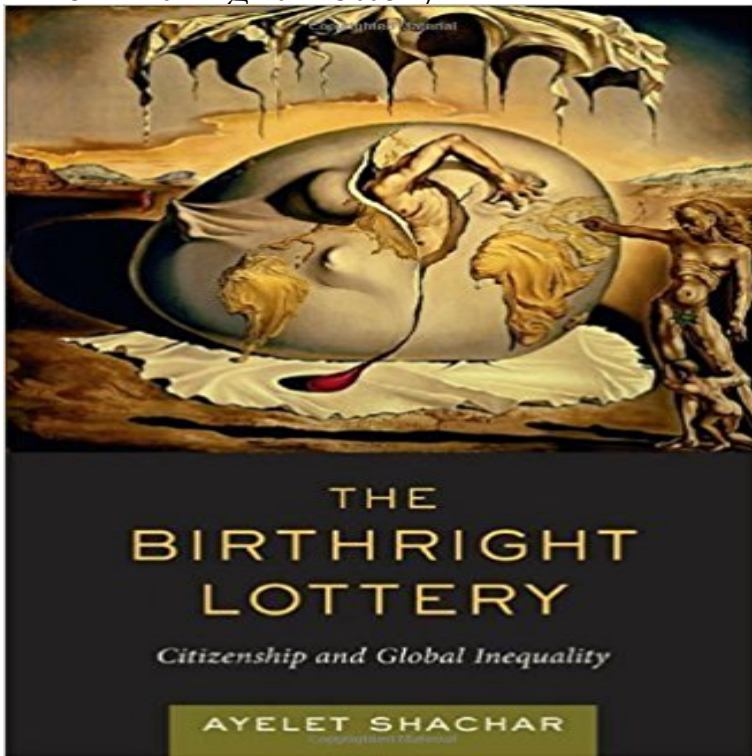


The Birthright Lottery



The vast majority of the global population acquires citizenship purely by accidental circumstances of birth.
