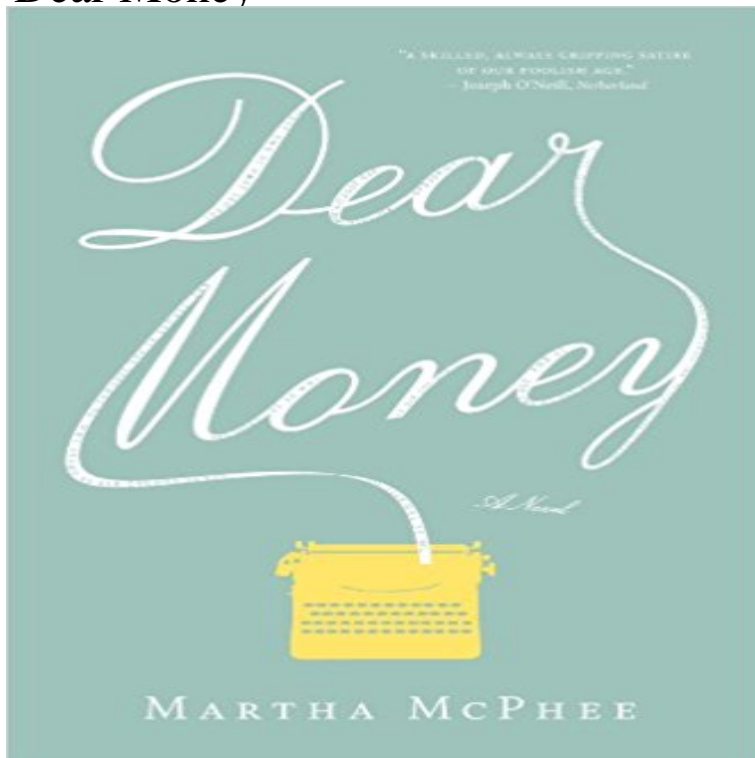


Dear Money
