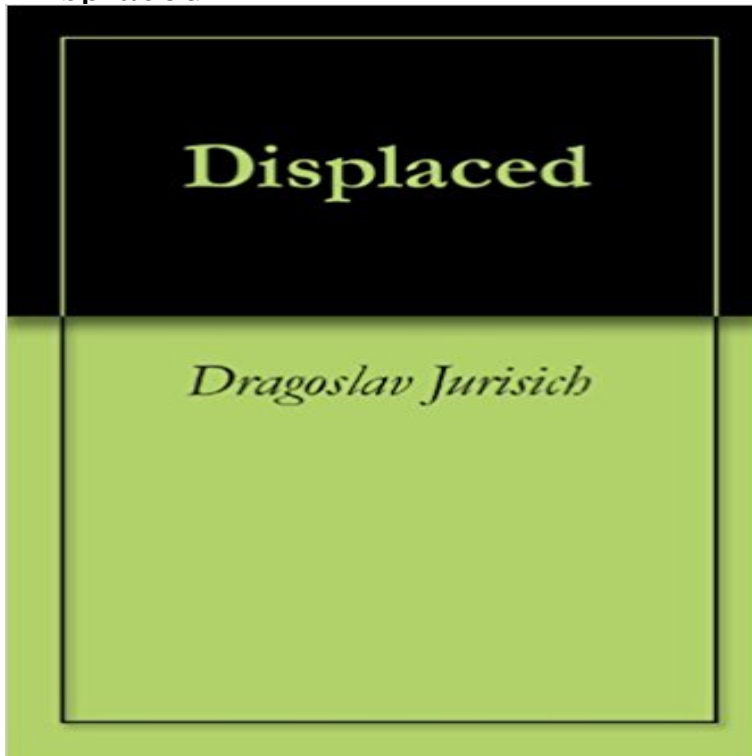


Displaced



Displaced by Dragoslav Jurisich tells the story of a group of people dealing with social and political struggle in western Europe, South America and Canada. Jurisich's *Displaced* is autobiographical creative nonfiction that follows the author's journey through France, Argentina and more, while he grapples with his feelings of displacement. Raised in Yugoslavia, he makes a dangerous escape without knowing why he does it—his only clear aim is to join his brother in France. United with his brother in Paris, Jurisich seeks out his father, and in doing so, uncovers unexpected and powerful truths about himself and his family. Woven throughout Jurisich's story are historical details about Bosnia, Croatia, Kosovo and the Balkan Peninsula. Aiming to be a very personal study of the immigration experience, *Displaced* also chronicles Jurisich's struggle to find a greater, less prosaic meaning in life.
