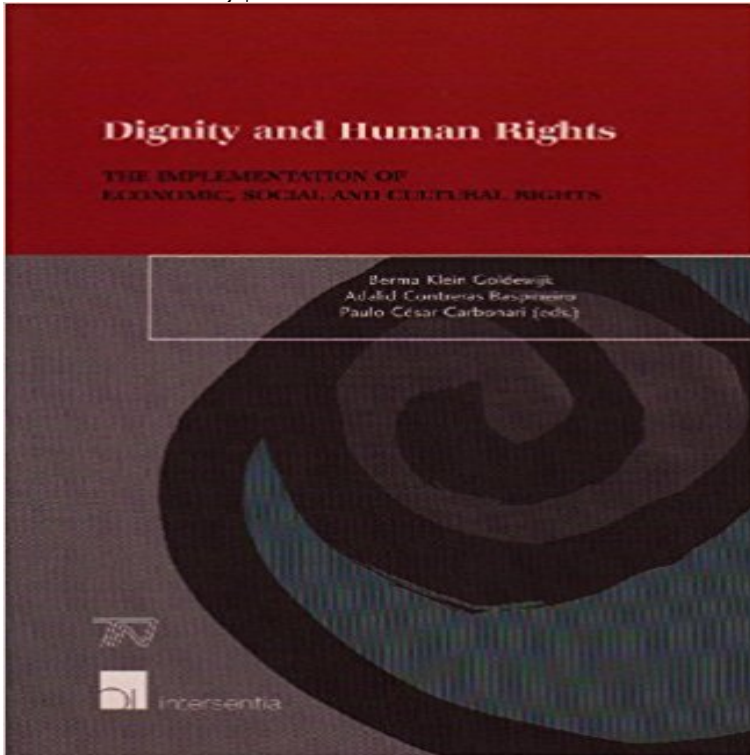


Dignity and Human Rights: The Implementation of Economic, Social and Cultural Rights
