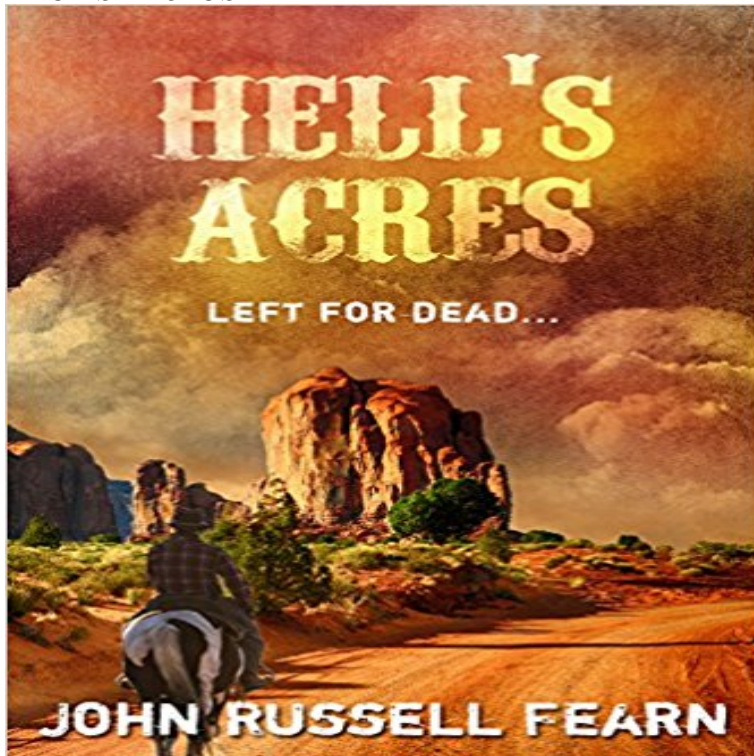


Hells Acres
