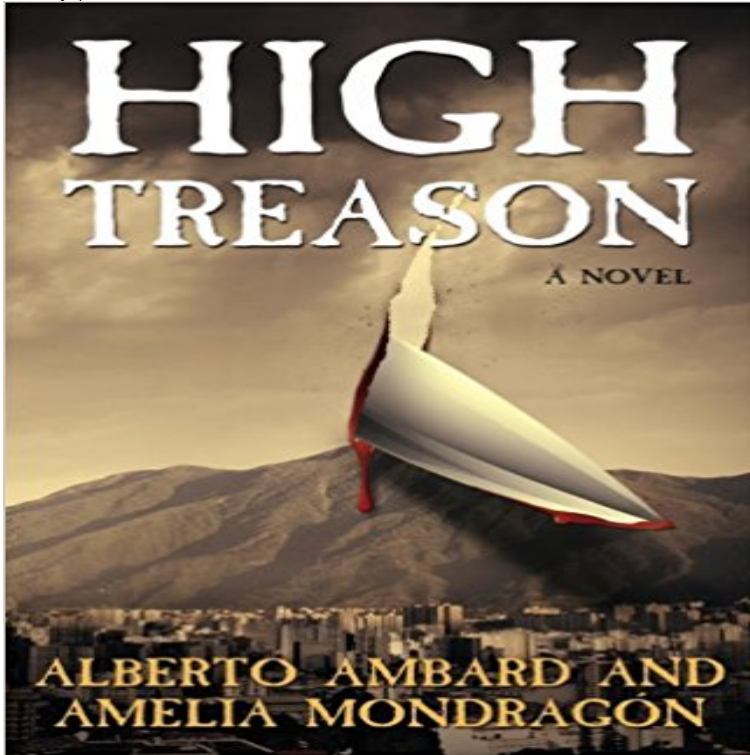


High Treason
