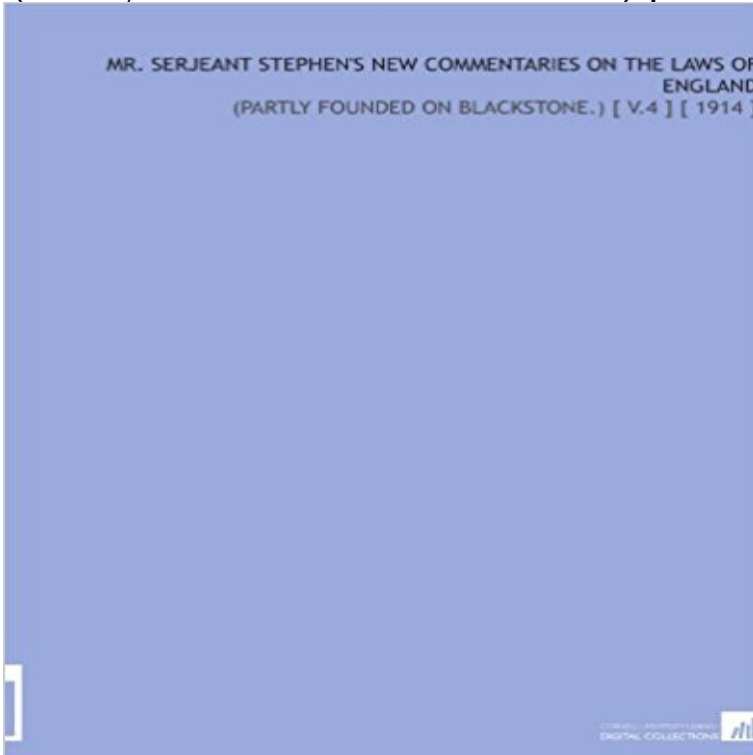


Mr. Serjeant Stephens New Commentaries on the Laws of England: (Partly Founded on Blackstone.) [V.4] [1914]
