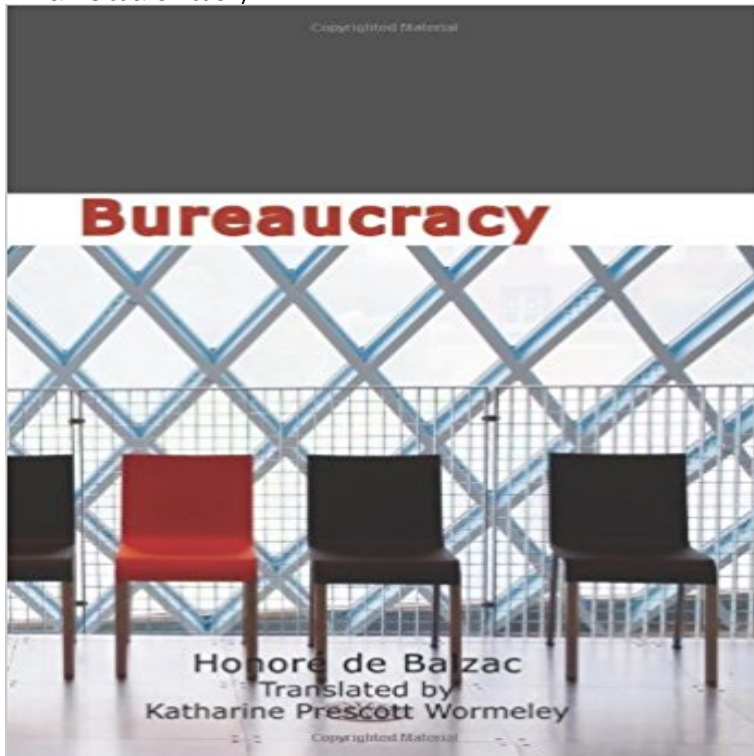


# Bureaucracy
