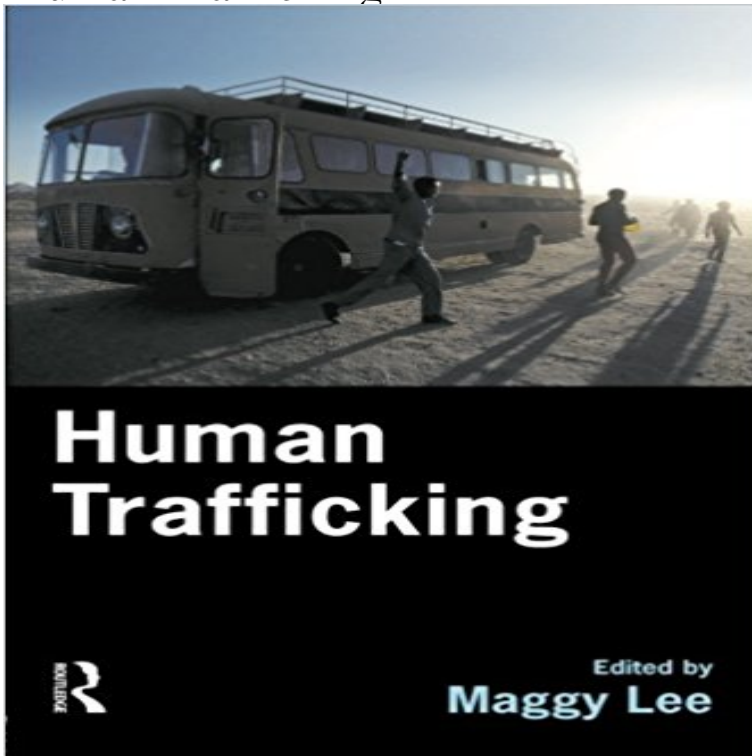


# Human Trafficking
