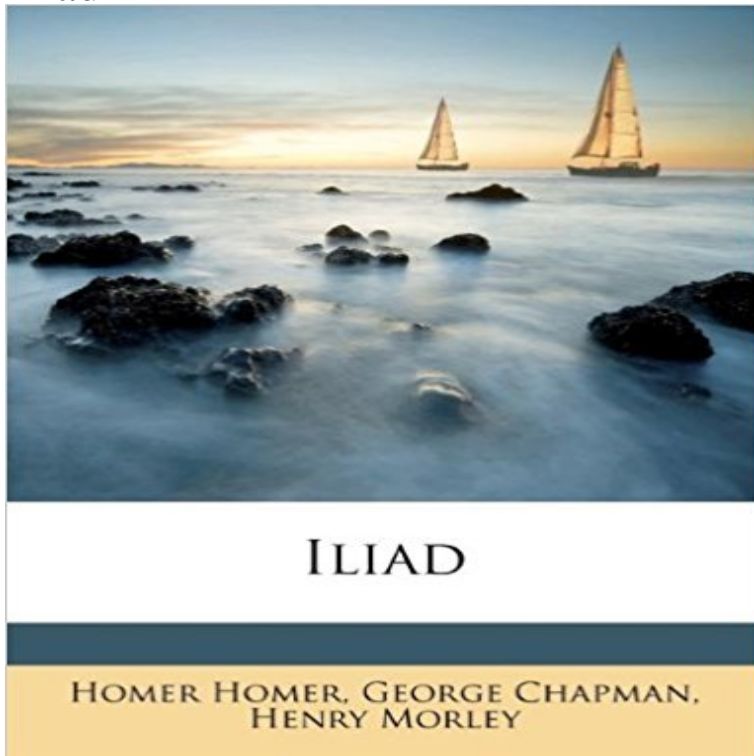


Iliad
