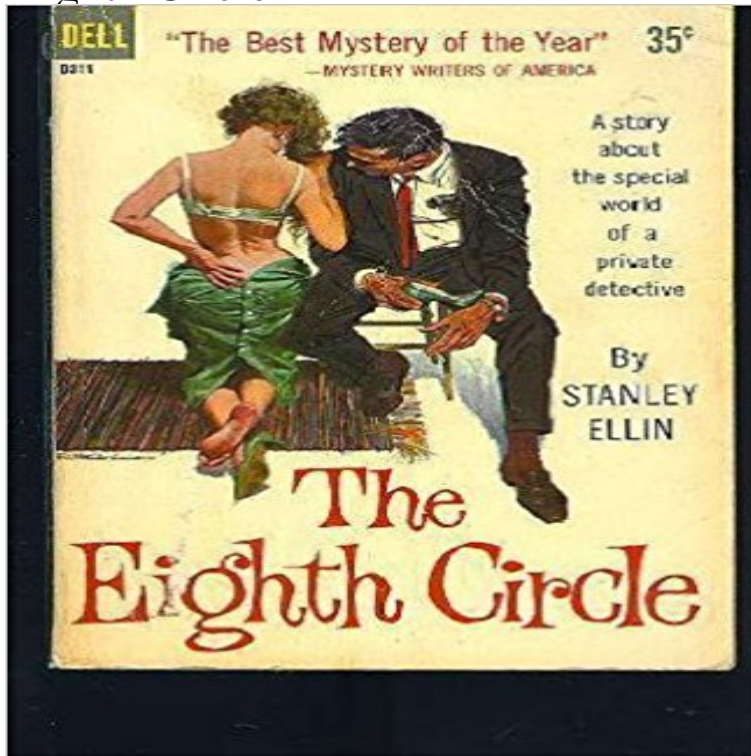


Eighth Circle
