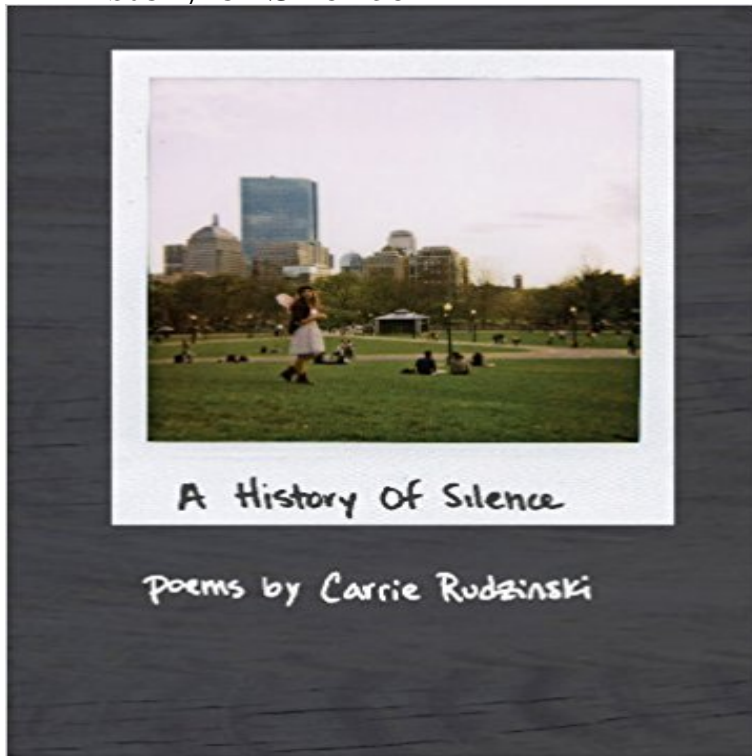


A History of Silence
