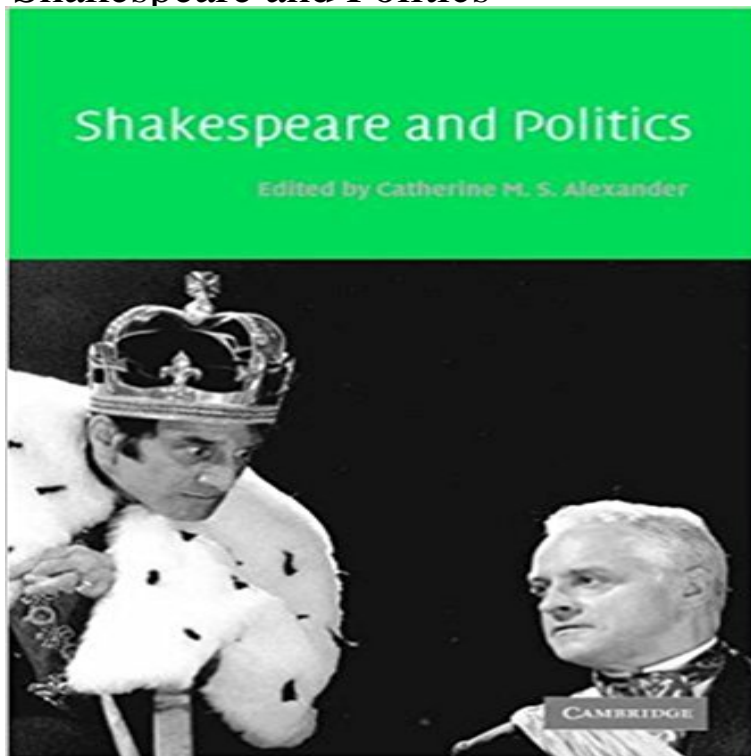


Shakespeare and Politics
