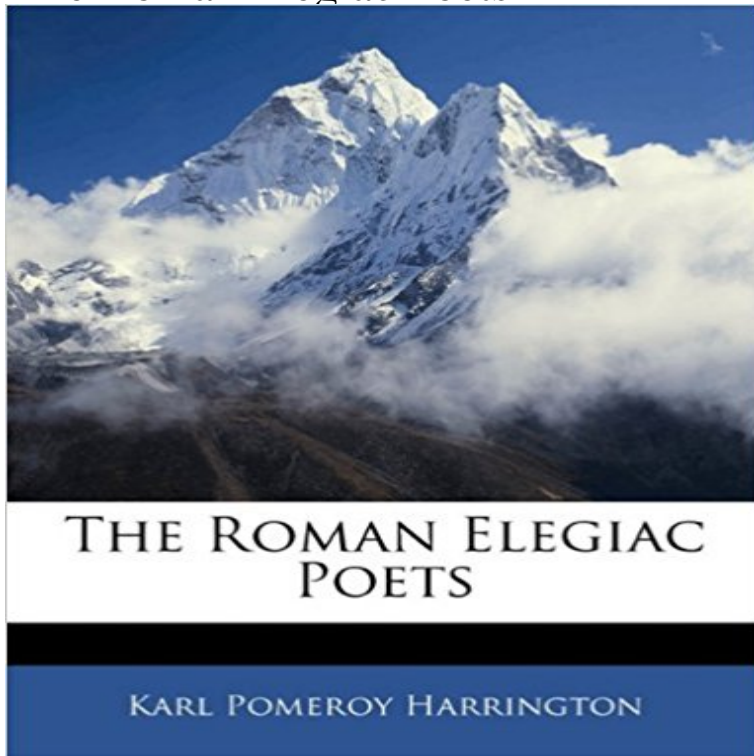


## The Roman Elegiac Poets
