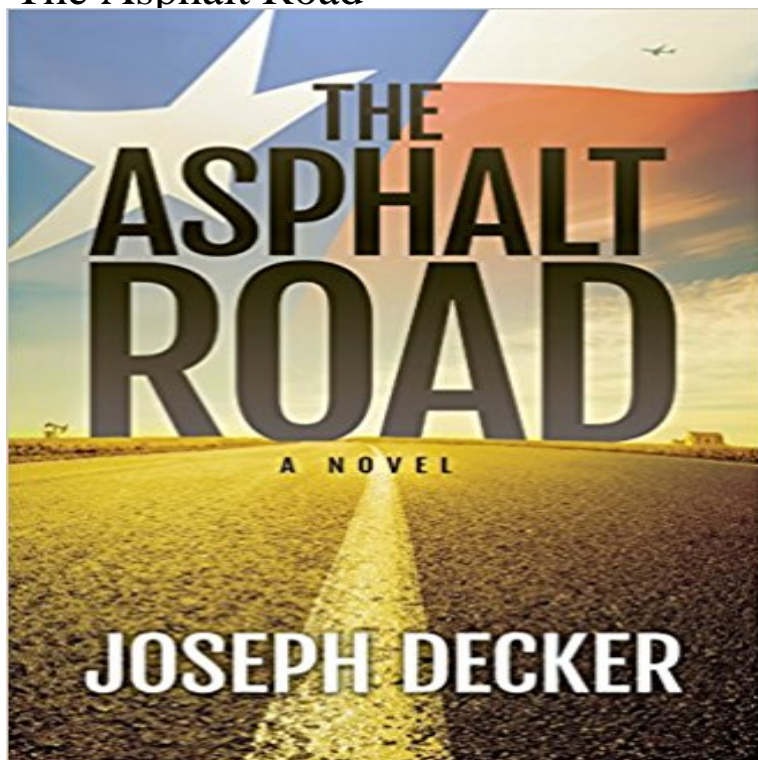


## The Asphalt Road
