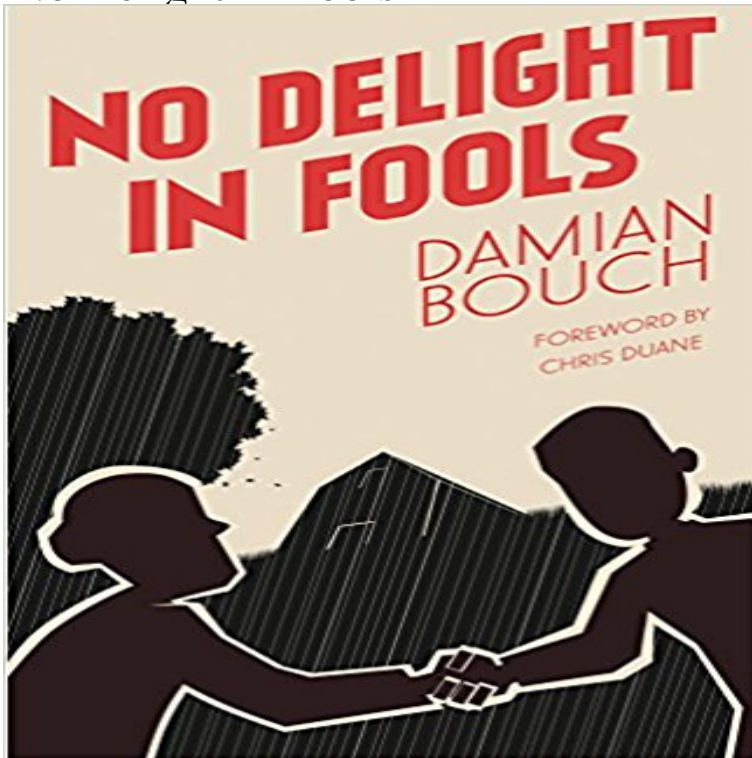


No Delight In Fools
