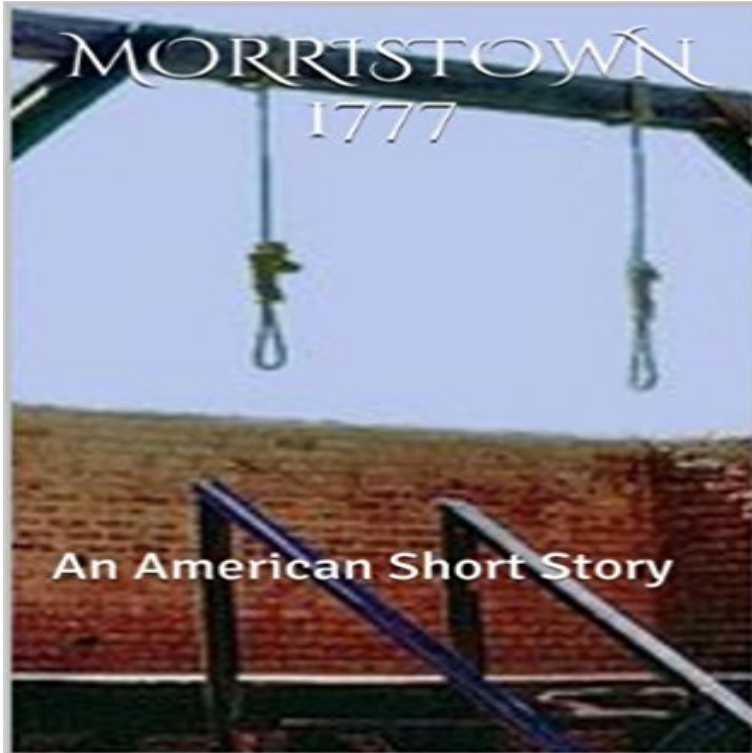


Morristown 1777: An American Short Story
