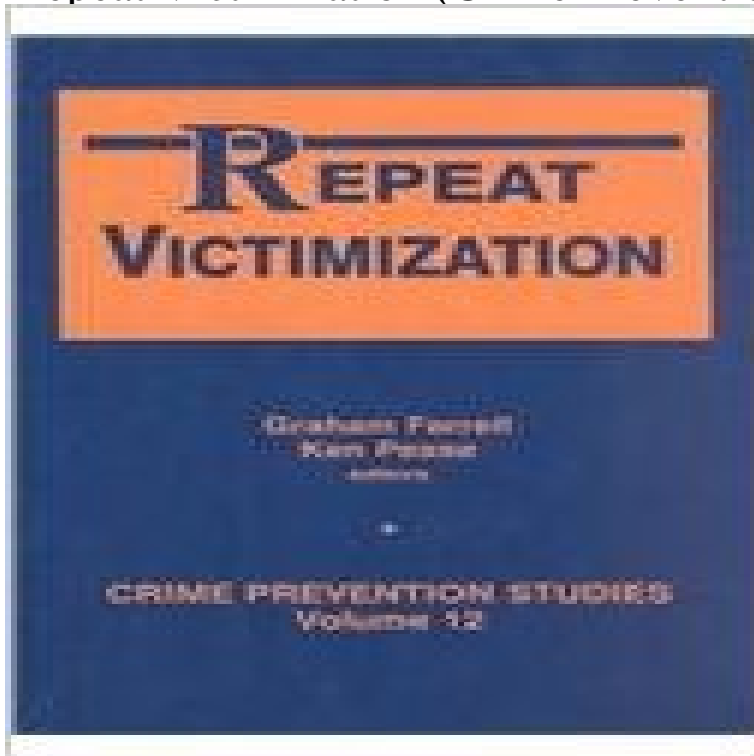


Repeat Victimization (Crime Prevention Studies, Vol. 12)
