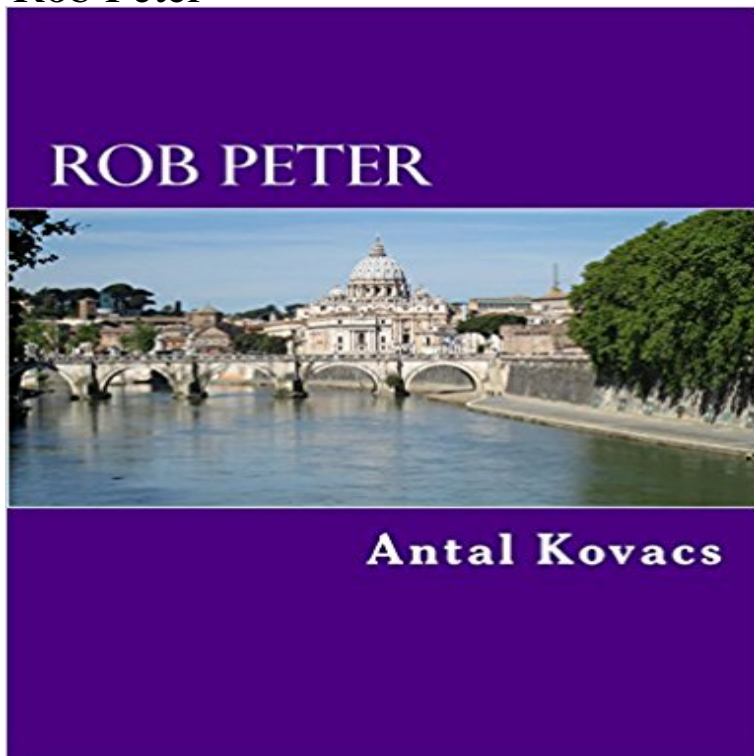


## Rob Peter
