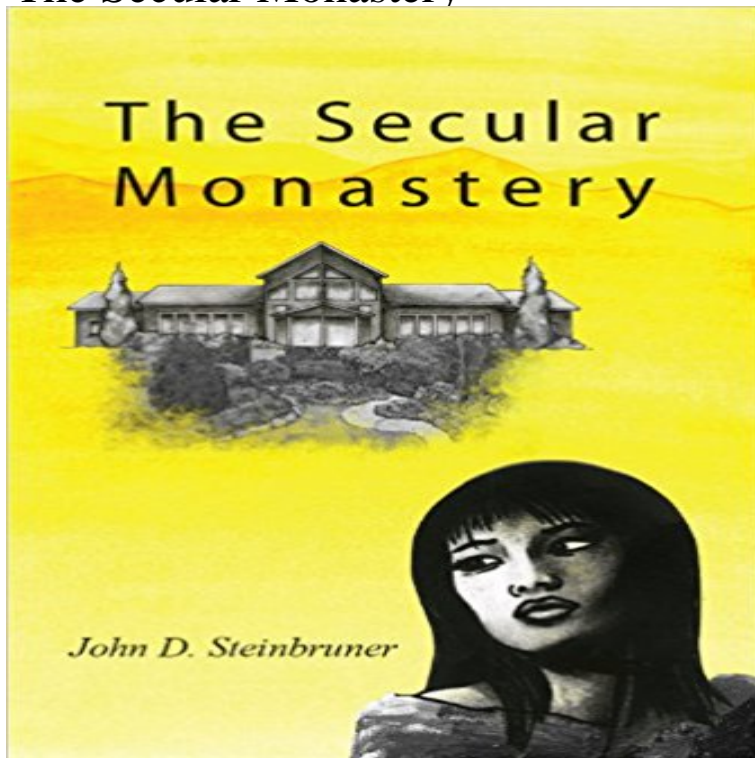


## The Secular Monastery
