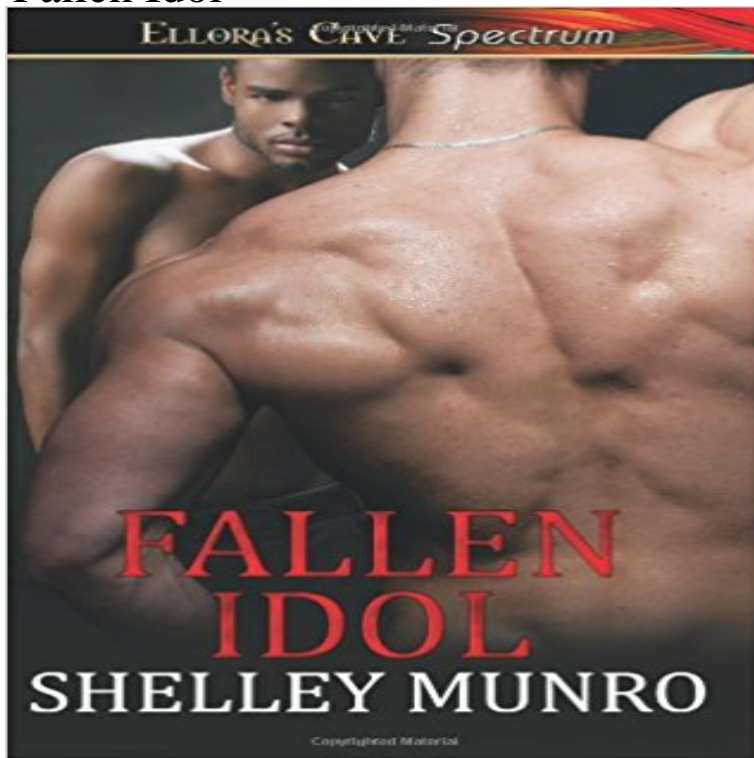


Fallen Idol
