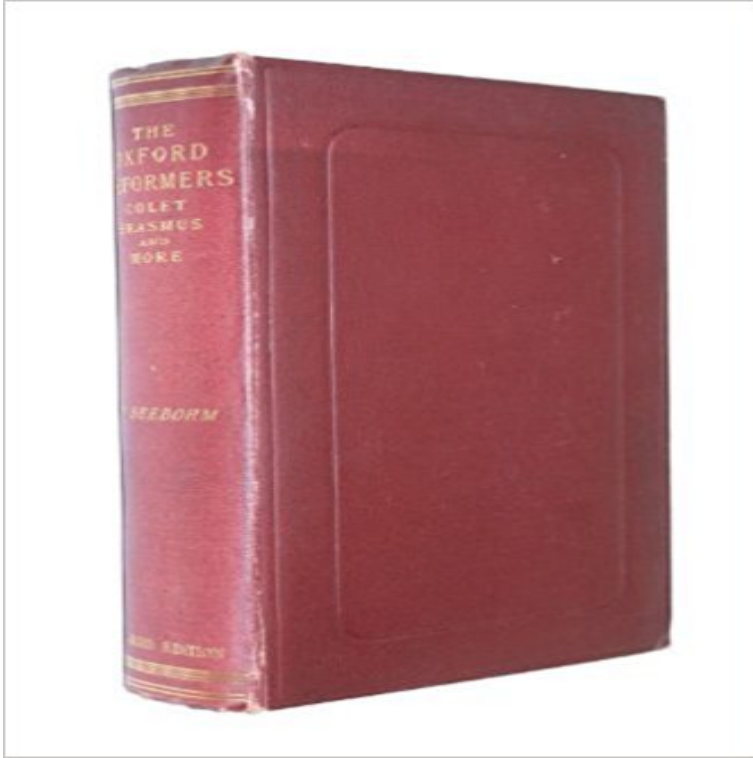


## The Oxford reformers John Colet, Erasmus, and Thomas More: Being a history of their fellow-work
