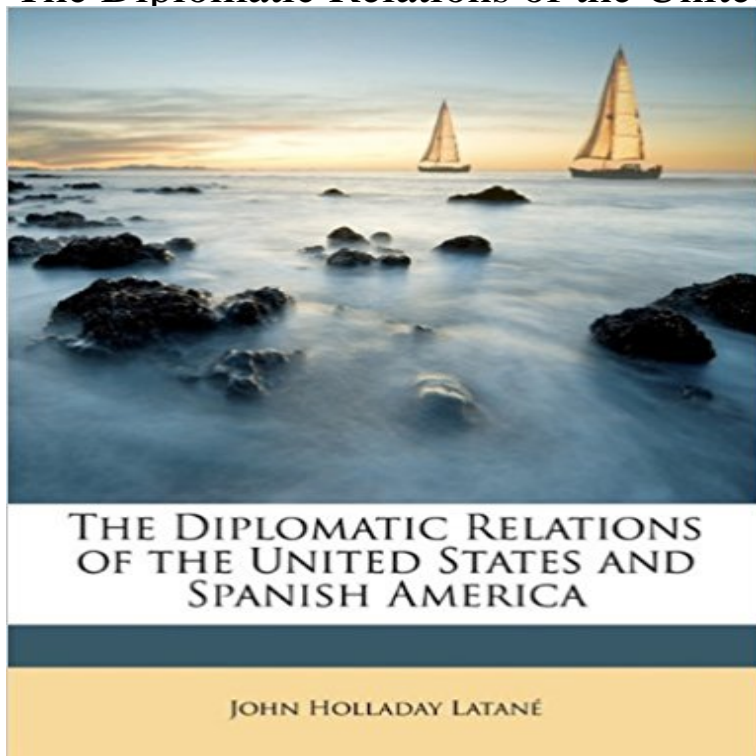


# The Diplomatic Relations of the United States and Spanish America
