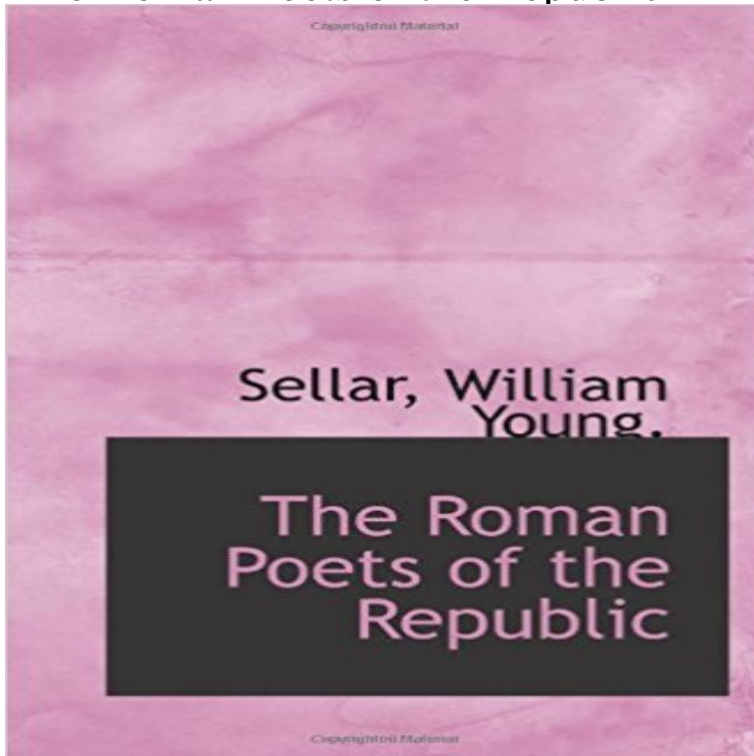


## The Roman Poets of the Republic
