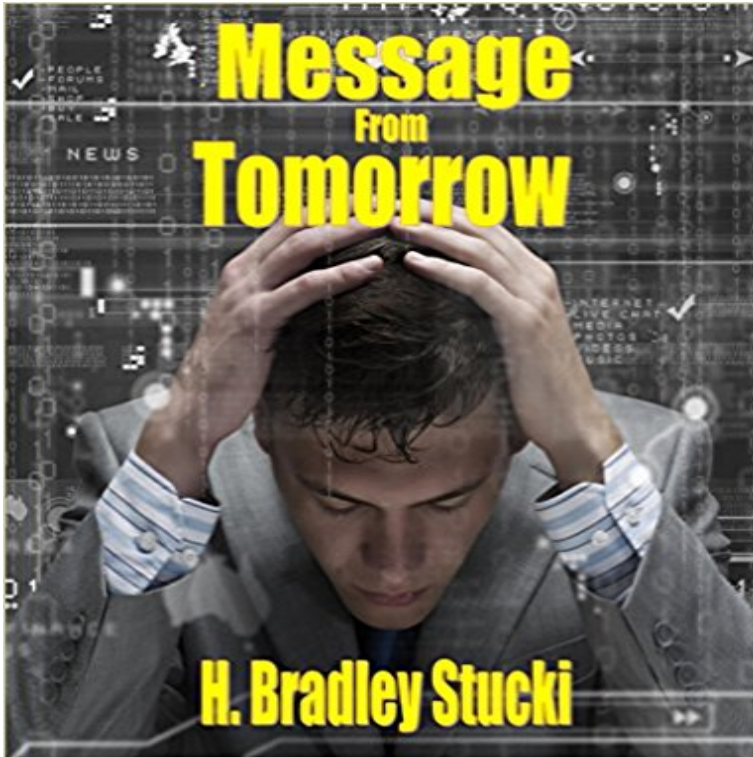


Message from Tomorrow: A Near Future Time Travel, Science Fiction Novella
