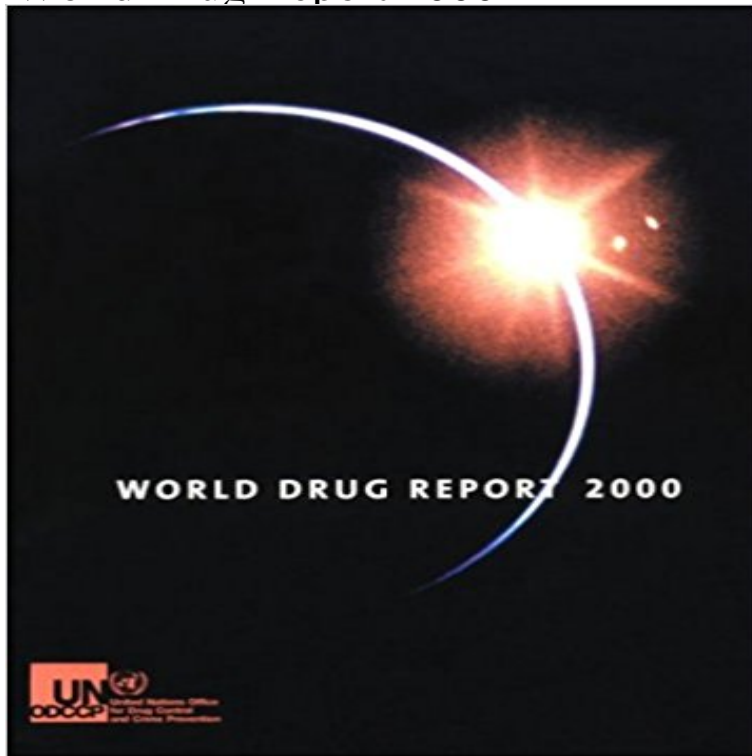


# World Drug Report 2000

In this Report, the United Nations Office for Drug Control and Crime Prevention describes and explains the extent and development of this complex problem and the important progress that has been made in recent years. Illustrated with numerous maps, graphs, charts, and tables, it provides unique insight into the realities of the international drug problem and reveals the most complete picture of the extent of the problem.
